



**Community Impact Statements (2016-2017):** 0 Submitted; Per the Annual report, no CISs were submitted.

**PLUC Bylaws:** The BHNC PLUC made ammendments were approved by a majority of the Board, however, it did not meet the requirements for Bylaws Ammendments. It was thus moved to the Rules & Elections Committee for review and ultimately approved by the Board under the proposed Bylaws Ammendments (as a whole). Implimentation is pending DONE approval.

**Hearings:**

1. **City Planning Commission:** the Appeal of Dry River Brewery Liquor Liscense (June 14th) was denied by the City Planning Commission found no reason to deny the Liscense
2. **Board of Public Works:** Removal of trees along Boyle, State, St. Louis, Soto (July 10th)
  - The trees are being removed as street repair, in relation to the Metro Active Transporation Program.
  - 77 removals, 105 will remain. Will be replaced with 200 mature trees, placed in 24-inch containers. And maintained by the BSS for 3 years.
  - **Tree removal/remain tally:** Boyle 22/60; State St 10/11; St. Louis 25/12; Soto St 23/22; (numbers stated at hear do not add up to 77)
  - Removals/Repairs will be used to help settle the law suit regarding sidewalk repair.
  - Root trimming was determined would be destabilizing to the tree.
  - Tree Replacement (in phases)
    - **Boyle, State St, St Louis:** 80 Australian Willow
    - **Boyle, State St, St Louis:** 80 Lavender Trumpet
    - **Soto:** 20 African Fern Pine
    - **Soto:** 20 Chinese Pistache
3. **7 – Eleven:** @ 3359 E. Whittier Blvd. 90023, ENV-2017-131-CE and ZA-2017-130-CUB;
  - **Hearing Date:** on June 6th, 2017, was placed on **hold** for determination by the applicant (7-11) to mitigate concerns. The hold status allowed for the PLUC Chair to submit the Board's **OPPOSITION** to the grant.
4. **1st/Boyle – "Laundromat" Site.** According to the LA Weekly, the site has been handed to a affordable housing developer. No clarification given. Waiting on response from the City.
5. **PLUC –** The PLUC heard general public comment on Excide,
6. **PLUC –** One of the PLUC items for Transparency in the General Plan was heard, but the committee felt that the language of the letter needed to be refined, prior to presentation to the Board.
7. **PLUC –** (optional) The audience at the PLUC meeting totaled approximately 12 Community Members. (take applause).
8. **Announcement:** The PLUC will be hearing on ZA-2017-2451-CUB, a request for a full bar liquour liscense in conjunction with a proposed Restaurant @ 243 – 251 South Mission Road at it's August 10th Meeting. And invites the Community to participate in this discussion.
