Summary of Motions Introduced (*New Legislation*)

Council File 19-1385, Welcome City / City of Los Angeles / Refugee Resettlement and Integration / 2020 Resettlement Cap Increase / Declaration: Introduced on November 8, 2019, and referred to Rules, Elections, and Intergovernmental Relations Committee. Resolution is declares the City of Los Angeles a Welcome City and affirms the support of resettling refugees no matter their race, religion, gender, gender identity, sexual orientation, nationality or country of origin.

Council File 19-1380, Cultural Traditions or Faith Practices / Civic Life Participation / Community Input Solicitation: Introduced on November 8, 2019 and referred to Rules, Elections, and Intergovernmental Relations Committee. Motion is instructing the Chief Legislative Analyst to report on ways to ensure that City departments avoid soliciting community input on culturally sensitive dates and times where residents may have to choose between participation in a City-sponsored meeting or their religious or cultural traditions.

Commissioners / Commission Appointment: Introduced on November 13, 2019, and referred to Transportation Committee. Mayor report dated November 12, 2019, is relative to the appointment of Ms. Jacqueline Le Kennedy to the Board of Taxicab Commissioners for the term ending June 30, 2024.

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Council File 13-1493-S9, Sidewalk and Park Vending Program / City Permits Fees

Establishment: Introduced on November 6, 2019 and referred to Budget and Finance Committee. The motion is instructing the Chief Legislative Analyst and the City Administrative Officer, with the assistance of any necessary departments, to report on the methodology used to establish City permit fees and permit fees associated with the Sidewalk and Park Vending Program, including a healthy cart permit, a location-based permit, and a subsidized permit fee for vendors facing financial hardship.

Take Action:

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Council File 19-1392, AB 5 (Gonzalez) / Unfair Competition Act / Worker Misclassification / Independent Contractors or Employees / Enforcement:

Introduced on November 12, 2019 and referred to Economic Development Committee. Motion is requesting the City Attorney and the Chief Legislative Analyst to report on options for the City of Los Angeles to enforce Assembly Bill 5 and related legal / programmatic factors to take into account when it becomes operative January 1, 2020

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Council File 19-0002-S184, Increase / State Payment Rate / Licensed Board and Care Facilities: Introduced on November 6, 2019 and referred to Rules, Elections, and Intergovernmental Relations Committee. Resolution is requesting that the City of Los Angeles include in its 2019-2020 State Legislative Program SPONSORSHIP and SUPPORT for any legislation or administrative action which would increase the State payment rate for licensed board and care facilities which serve vulnerable communities, especially seniors with mental health issues.
