Council File 18-0737, Plastic Utensils-On-Request / Ordinance: Introduced on August 7, 2018 and referred to Energy, Climate Change, and Environmental Justice Committee. The motion is instructing the Bureau of Sanitation (BOS) to report to the City Council in 60 days on the feasibility of implementing a Plastic Utensils-On-Request ordinance which requires restaurants, and other food service providers, to withhold plastic utensils unless a customer requests them.

Council File 18-0728, Los Angeles Police Department / Sexual Assault Response Team (SART) / Sexual Assault Investigations / Reimbursement Rate Increase:

Introduced on August 3, 2018, and referred to Personnel and Animal Welfare Committee. The motion is instructing the Personnel Department to increase the reimbursement rate for all forensic evidentiary examinations conducted by Sexual Assault Response Team Centers at the request of the Police Department to \$1,020 per exam, with this rate to be adjusted annually based on changes in the CPI, in line with the amount paid per exam by the County of Los Angeles.

The Resolution is requesting that the City of Los Angeles include in its 2017-2018 State Legislative Program SUPPORT for SB 452 (Glazer), which will financially support California recyclers and bring our statewide beverage container recycling rate back to meeting or exceeding statutory goals.

The Resolution is requesting that the City of Los Angeles include in its 2017-2018 State Legislative Program SUPPORT for SB 833 (McGuire), which would require that the Governor's Office of Emergency Services develop voluntary guidelines for alerting and warning the public in case of emergencies and require additional training for local emergency office personnel.

The Resolution is requesting that the City of Los Angeles include in its 2017-2018 State Legislative Program SUPPORT for SB 168 (Wieckowski), which will require beverage containers generated and sold in the State of California to be made, in part, with recycled material.

The Resolution is requesting that the City of Los Angeles include in its 2017-2018 State Legislative Program SUPPORT for Veterans and Affordable Housing Act of 2018 (Proposition 1) that places a \$4 billion General Obligation Bond on the November 2018 ballot to fund affordable housing programs and the veterans homeownership program.

The Resolution is requesting that the City of Los Angeles include in its 2017-2018 State Legislative Program SUPOPRT for AB 186 (Eggman), which would allow the City of Los Angeles and the County of Los Angeles to open supervised substance consumption program sites in an effort to reduce overdoses and communicable diseases and partner those sites with medical and health professionals to offer counseling and services.
