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Council File 18-1200-S25, Berta Avila / Cultural Affairs Commission / Commission Appointment: Introduced on August 14, 2018 and referred to Arts, Entertainment, Parks and River Committee. Mayor's report is relative to the appointment of Berta Avila to the Cultural Affairs Commission for the term ending June 30, 2023. Ms. Avila will fill the vacancy created by Josefina Lopez, whose term has expired.

Take Action:

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Council File 18-1200-S24, Harout Semerdjian / Human Relations Commission / Commission Appointment: Introduced on August 14, 2018, and referred to Immigrant Affairs, Civil Rights, and Equity Committee. Mayor report is relative to the appointment of Harout "Harry" Semerdjian to the Human Relations Commission for the term ending June 30, 2022. Mr. Semerdjian will fill the vacancy created by Marco Ramirez, whose term has expired.

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Council File 18-1200-S23, Jose Sandoval / Board of Animal Services /

Commission Appointment: Introduced on August 14, 2018 and referred to Personnel and Animal Welfare Committee. Mayor report is relative to the appointment of Jose Sandoval to the Board of Animal Services for the term ending June 30, 2023. Mr. Sandoval will fill the vacancy created by Layne Dicker, whose term has expired.

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Council File 18-0821, Mobile Data Carriers / Billing and Throttling Practices /

Disaster Situations: Introduced on August 24, 2018 and referred to Rules, Elections, and Intergovernmental Relations Committee. The motion is requesting that representatives from the four major mobile data carriers, AT&T Wireless, Sprint, T-Mobile and Verizon, make their staff experts on billing and throttling available to explain their practices as it relates to disaster situations.

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Council File 18-0786, Los Angeles Fire Department (LAFD) / Community

Emergency Response Team (Cert) Supply Cache Pilot Program: Introduced on August 17, 2018 and referred to Public Safety Committee. The motion is instructing the LAFD to report on their CERT supply cache pilot and the necessary maintenance and replenishment of supplies within 60 days. Additionally, the motion is instructing the Fire Department, Emergency Management Department and the Department of Neighborhood Empowerment, with the assistance of the General Services Department and Recreation and Parks to report within 60 days on the creation of a pilot program to

place cache units at City facilities within the boundaries of each Neighborhood Council in the Council District 3. The report should provide options for Neighborhood Councils to purchase the caches, and possible metrics on determining the success of a pilot.

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Council File 12-1681-S3, Neighborhood Council Subdivision Reforms: Introduced on August 14, 2018 and referred to Health, Education, and Neighborhood Councils Committee.

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Council File 17-0973-S1, Illegal Firearm Recovery Reward Program: Introduced on August 17, 2018 and referred to Budget and Finance Committee. The motion is moving that \$25,000 be reappropriated from the Reserve Fund to General City Purposes Fund, Illegal Firearm Recovery Reward Program to implement the Illegal Firearm Recovery Reward Program previously approved by the Council.

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Council File 18-0002-S109, HR. 6043 / S. 3032 / Strengthening the Tenth Amendment Through Entrusting States (STATES) Act: Introduced on August 14, 2018 and referred to Rules, Elections, and Intergovernmental Relations Committee. The Resolution is requesting that the City of Los Angeles include in its 2017-2018 Federal Legislative Program SUPOPRT for HR. 6043 and S 3032, also known as the STATES Act, which would allow state governments to enforce its marijuana laws without undue federal intervention.

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Council File 18-0002-S111, Safe Parking Program / Department of Motor Vehicles / Supplemental Services: Introduced on August 17, 2018 and referred to Rules, Elections, and Intergovernmental Relations Committee. The Resolution is requesting that the City of Los Angeles include in its 2017-2018 Federal and State Legislative Program SUPOPRT for the legislative and/or any administrative action that would require the Department of Motor Vehicles to provide supplemental services to Safe Parking programs.

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Council File 18-0002-S112, SB 834 (Jackson) / AB 1775 (Muratsuchi): Introduced on August 17, 2018 and referred to Rules, Elections, and Intergovernmental Relations Committee. The Resolution is requesting that the City of Los Angeles include in its 2017-2018 State Legislative Program SUPOPRT for SB 834 (Jackson) and AB 1775 (Muratsuchi), which will ban any new oil and gas infrastructure within the State's jurisdiction and thereby protect California's coastal waters from further pollution caused by offshore oil and gas exploration.

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
