1. Meeting to be called to order at 5:10 PM

2. Roll Call Present: Carlos Montes, Rosalinda Carreon, Calvin Nelson, quorum met.

3. General Public Comment

- a. Limited to 2 minutes per speaker)
- b. Initials I.M. did not want name in public: has a big concern with the large amount of trucks filled with salvage parked along St. Louis Street next to Hollenbeck Park parking lot area. Also, with high rate of speed cars travel on St. Louis St. between 4th St. and 6th St.

4. Presenters/ Gov't Reports

- a. Hollenbeck Park staff representative: Sandra Pineda welcomed all to Hollenbeck Park, thanked the BHNC for the \$500.00 grant for the Halloween festival and gave out a list of the new and current classes, announced a band festival in bandshell set for October 5, 2018 at 5 pm, and is looking forward to working together to make Hollenbeck Park a welcoming attractive and active park for the community.

5. Neighborhood Committee Business

- a. Moved by Rosalinda Carreon to get the following improvements on South St. Louis St.: a marked crosswalk at South St. Louis St and Hollenbeck Drive, speed bumps at between Hollenbeck Drive and 6th St. and a second speed bump between 6th St and 4th, a passenger pickup only painted in front of 610 So. St. Louis St. a red no parking zone at entry to drive way for 610 So. St. Louis St. motion second by Calvin Nelson. Public comment local residents express concern for safety of residents, and park visitors with the high speed of cars on So. St. Louis st traveling South from Boyle Ave to 4th St. Also, residents express fear with high speed of cars and the dangerous difficulty with passengers especially disabled residents exiting cars and medical passenger vans in front of 610 So. St. Louis. Discussion held in support of motion by Rosalinda Carreon and Calvin Nelson that due to the dangerous high speed of cars traveling on So. St. Louis St. they want the LA City to install speed bumps, crosswalks and passenger loading zone marked areas. Motion passed unanimously.

- b. Moved by Calvin Nelson and second by Rosalinda Carreon to have BHNC Townhall at Hollenbeck Park on October 27, 2018 from 3:30PM to 6pm presenting the CA Statewide initiatives and the election of a Superintendent of Public Instruction set for November 6, 2018. Townhall will promote voter registration and voter turnout. Public Comment: Naomi Duncanson-Guzman stated she supported the town hall so that local resident's area informed about initiatives and come and vote. General comments in support. Rosalinda gave information on Proposition 10 for rental control. Carlos indicated that speakers can cover a review of the initiatives and a local LAUSD teacher can present the Superintendent of Public Instruction roles and duties and election. Motion passed unanimously.
- c. Motion to discuss and possible action to participate in the Halloween Festival at Hollenbeck Park on October 31, 2018. Carlos Montes announced that we all can participate and volunteer in Halloween Festival since the BHNC Board has already voted to support and donate \$500.00 for festival expenses.
