Please note that under the Brown Act, the Board is prevented from acting on a matter that you bring to its attention during the General Public Comment period; however, the issue raised by a member of the public may become the subject of a future Board meeting. Public comment is limited to 2 minute per speaker, unless adjusted by the presiding officer of the Committee.

BHNC BOARD MEMBER ATTENDANCE – BHNC Board Members that are not members of TEC, are allowed to attend and partake in Committee Discussion, as long as the total members present do not constitute the minimum (6) BHNC Board Members needed to pass an actionable item at a Regular BHNC Board Meeting. If this number is exceeded only BHNC Board members on the TEC may partake in the discussion. All other BHNC Board Members must then remain silent and participate only as observers. The TEC Chair reserves the right under the Brown Act to allow for the maximum of nine (9) Board Members to participate in the discussion. Brown Act § 54952.2 (c) (6)
